STUDYING AND LIVING IN CARINTHIA

Carinthia, Austria's southernmost federal province, is home to 560,000 people and is renowned for its high quality of life. Located in the heart of the Alps-Adriatic region at the three-border triangle of Austria, Italy and Slovenia, it uniquely combines alpine and Mediterranean influences, providing a temperate climate and rich cultural diversity.

With its idyllic mountains, crystal-clear lakes and charming towns, Carinthia offers an abundance of year-round sports and leisure activities.

In addition to its geographical advantages, Carinthia also provides an excellent social and health care system and is considered a particularly safe, prosperous and livable region. Still, the cost of living remains relatively affordable compared to other Austrian regions and major cities.

As an economic and technological hub, Carinthia has a strong industry offering numerous job opportunities, supported by a network of research centers and educational institutions like CUAS, which emphasize science and innovation.

Our five campuses, spread across four cities, each offer a unique study experience, making them an attractive destination for international students seeking an enriching academic journey.

Estimated monthly cost of living expenses in Austria are listed in the table below. Please note that these costs are average estimates and will vary depending on your personal lifestyle. Compared to other parts of Austria, life in Carinthia is slightly more affordable and the estimated monthly expenses may actually be lower than those listed below.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Applications for the upcoming accademic year may be submitted starting November 1. Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis. Early applications are recommended in order to secure a study place. You can find more detailed information about the application deadlines on the website of the respective study program.

Application period 1 o1 November – 15 March
Application period 2 16 March – 15 May
Application period 3 16 May – 15 July
Application period 4 16 July – 30 September

APPLICATION & ADMISSION PROCESS

2. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

If you meet the formal requirements, you will be invited to complete the admission procedure. In this procedure, we will conduct an admission interview with all applicants, which will be taken into account in the allocation of study places. In some programs, we also use written ranking tests, job-specific aptitude tests and assessment centers.

They are happy to help you and are available to answer any questions you may have about the admission process.



3. LEARNING AGREEMENT

Once you have been accepted, the next step is to sign the Learning Agreement, pay the tuition fees of € 363.36 (€ 500 for non-EU countries) plus the ÖH fee of about € 25 per semester (which is adjusted annually) and enroll in the program. Please keep in mind that the deadlines for signing the Learning Agreement and paying the tuition fees have to be met. Details can be found in your admission letter.

After your successful enrollment, nothing stands in the way of your studies at CUAS. We look forward to welcoming you soon as part of our student community!

TRANSLATION AND LEGALIZATION OF DOCUMENTS

International applicants have to provide translated copies of their documents in German or English. The translation needs to be done by a sworn and officially accredited translator.

Depending on the country in which your documents were issued, they might need to be legalized in the form of an apostille or a full diplomatic legalization. 


